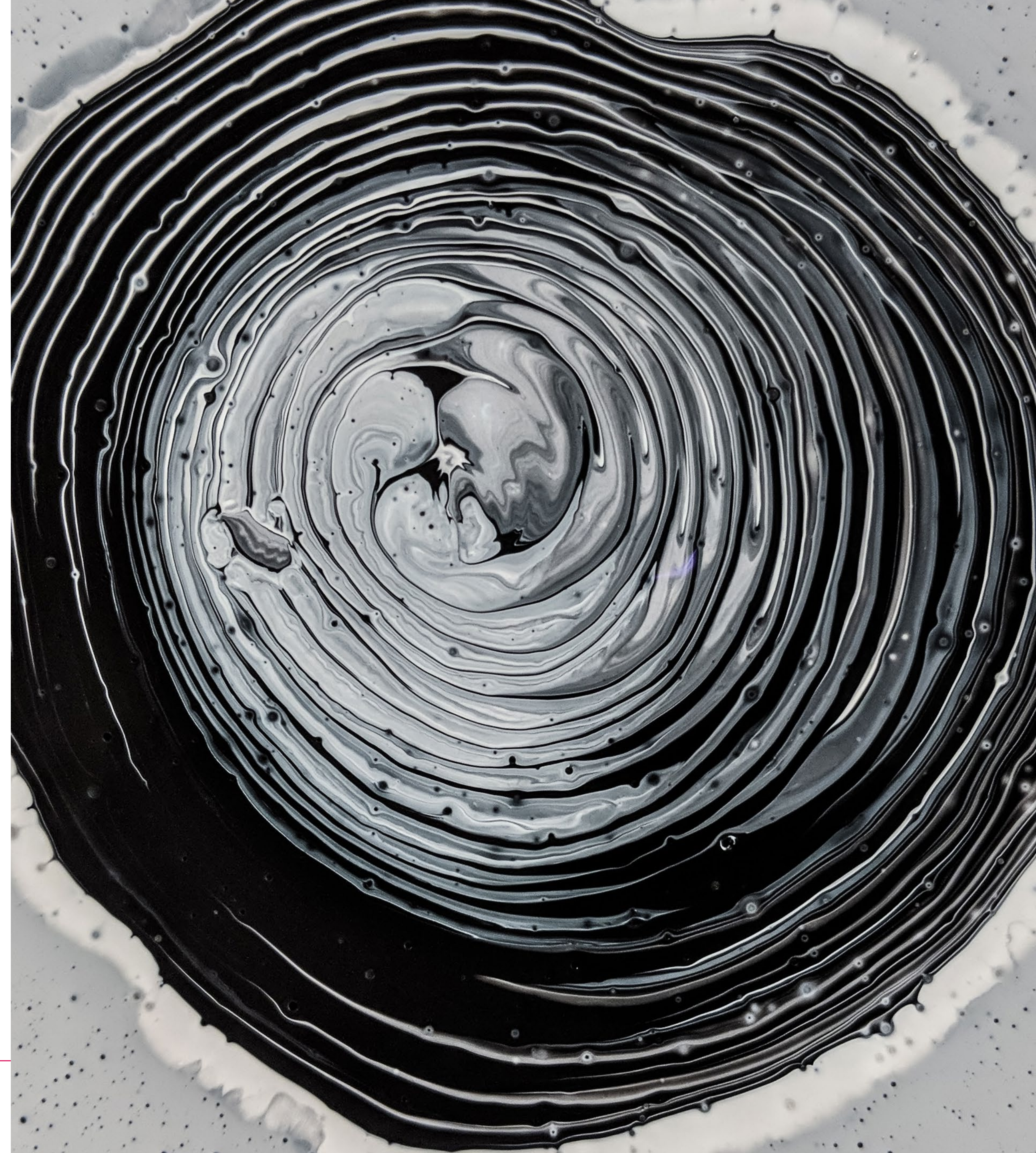

Whistleblowing is one of the key components of comprehensive fraud risk management, which aims at deterring, detecting, addressing and dealing with the effects of fraud and other irregularities.

It works by providing a medium through which concerned persons can disclose or report wrongdoing without fear of victimisation. 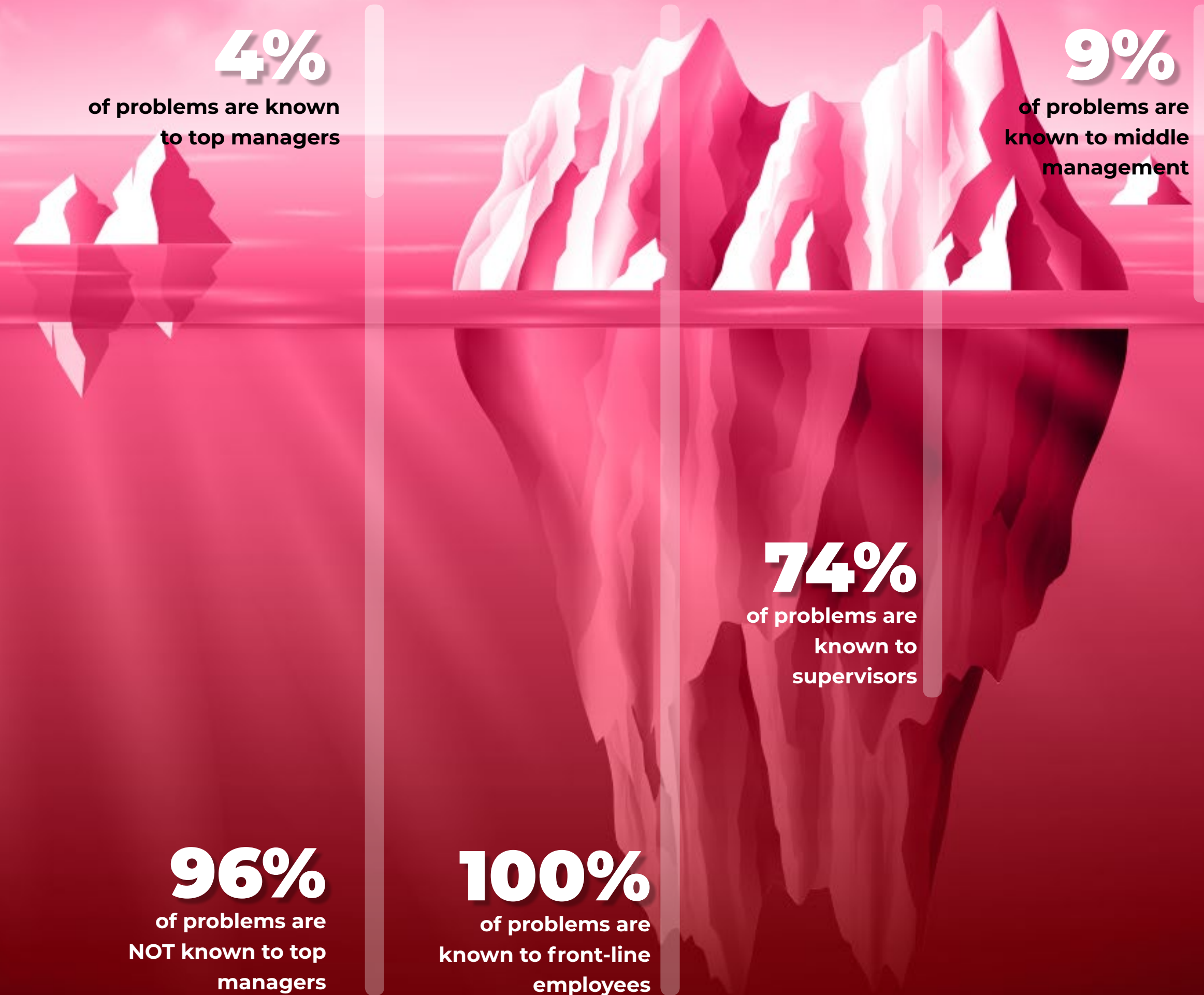
Key requirements for effective whistleblowing are that:
